<p>3</p>	<p>The use of technology has introduced its own ethical issues. One such issue is cyber bullying, in which people can be sent inappropriate or harassing messages, or be bullied through social media. This can be a problem because this can happen continuously at all times, day or night, and the culprits can be anonymous. It can be very distressing to the victims and it can lead to them having mental health issues, withdrawing from society, or not going to school.</p> <p>Technology use can also give access to inappropriate materials such as pornography or extreme political views, and put people under pressure to access these materials, in order to be seen as part of the group.</p> <p>Another issue is loss of privacy because technology is switched on twenty-four hours a day, meaning everyone is available all the time, and often feel pressured to respond to messages whenever they are received. People can have the impression that they are expected to be available all the time, which can lead to stress or negative mental health problems.</p> <p>These issues can be controlled if everyone behaves responsibly when using technology. This can be by refusing to become involved in negative activities, or reporting them to someone who is in a position to do something about them.
