### Section B: Dictation

The dictation is assessed for Communication of meaning (AO1) and Transcription and grammatical accuracy (AO3). The response is assessed across all the spoken extracts as a whole (maximum 8 marks).

Level	Mark	Communication of meaning (AO1)
4	4	The meaning of the spoken extracts is always or almost always communicated clearly.
3	3	The meaning of the spoken extracts is mostly communicated.
2	2	The meaning of the spoken extracts is sometimes communicated.
1	1	The meaning of the spoken extracts is rarely communicated.
0	0	The meaning of the spoken extracts communicated does not meet the standard for Level 1 at this tier.

Level	Mark	Transcription and grammatical accuracy (AO3)
4	4	Words are frequently transcribed correctly with a good level of grammatical accuracy.
3	3	Words are generally transcribed correctly with a reasonable level of grammatical accuracy.
2	2	Words are occasionally transcribed correctly with a limited level of grammatical accuracy.
1	1	Words are very rarely transcribed correctly with a very limited level of grammatical accuracy.
0	0	Transcription and grammatical accuracy do not meet the standard for Level 1 at this tier.

For each task:

0	No part of the message is conveyed.

2	2	Pronunciation is rarely accurate.
1	1	Pronunciation is very rarely accurate.
0	0	Does not meet the standard required for Level 1 at this tier.

Response to compulsory questions (10 marks AO1)

The response to the four compulsory questions is marked as a whole, according to the following criteria. Marks are not awarded to individual questions.

4	7–8	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>At least three questions are answered clearly.</li> <li>One answer has an extended response, and at least one other is developed well.</li> </ul>
3	5–6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>At least two questions are answered clearly.</li> <li>One answer is developed well, and at least one other is developed minimally.</li> </ul>
2	3–4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>At least two questions are answered understandably.</li> <li>One answer is developed minimally.</li> </ul>
1	1–2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>At least one question is answered understandably.</li> <li>The answer(s) may be a very limited response.</li> </ul>
0	0	Does not meet the standard required for Level 1 at this tier.

Response to the content of the photos (5 marks AO2)

5	5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Quite a lot of information is conveyed.</li> <li>Information may lack clarity from time to time.</li> </ul>
4	4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Some information is conveyed.</li> <li>Information lacks clarity from time to time.</li> </ul>
3	3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Some information is conveyed.</li> <li>Information lacks clarity from time to time, and occasionally messages break down.</li> </ul>
2	2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Little information is conveyed.</li> <li>Messages regularly break down.</li> </ul>
1	1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Very little information is conveyed.</li> <li>Messages regularly break down, or the very little language produced is barely understandable.</li> </ul>

*Sur la première photo, ils célèbrent un mariage. Par contre, sur la deuxième photo, c'est le jour de Noël.*

*Sur la première photo, je vois beaucoup de personnes – un couple gay et d'autres gens. Je pense que les deux hommes du centre sont les maris. Ils coupent le gâteau sur la table.*

*Ils sont avec leurs amis et leur famille et tout le monde est content. Ils vont boire du vin.*

*Sur la deuxième photo, je vois une famille de trois personnes dans sa maison. Il y a une mère avec deux enfants – un garçon et une fille.*

*Le petit garçon a un cadeau. C'est peut-être très tôt le matin, le 25 décembre.*

4	4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Some variety of vocabulary and structures, but with regular repetition.</li> <li>• Frequent minor errors and some major errors in most responses to questions.</li> </ul>
3	3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Limited variety of vocabulary and structures, with regular repetition.</li> <li>• Very frequent minor and frequent major errors in most responses to questions.</li> </ul>
2	2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Very limited variety of vocabulary and structures, with regular repetition.</li> <li>• Very frequent minor and very frequent major errors in nearly all responses to questions.</li> </ul>
1	1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hardly any variety of vocabulary and structures.</li> <li>• Minor and major errors in all responses to questions.</li> </ul>
0	0	The language does not meet the standard required for Level 1 at this tier.

# Writing

## Section A

### Question 1

Each of the five sentences is marked separately and is worth a maximum of 2 marks for AO2 (10 marks in total). The whole sentence should be considered when awarding the mark.

2	The relevant message is clearly communicated.
1	The message is relevant but has some ambiguity and causes a delay in communication.
0	The message is irrelevant or cannot be understood.

Example answers:

- 1.1 *Voici mes amis.*
- 1.2 *On fait du shopping.*
- 1.3 *J'ai mon portable.*
- 1.4 *C'est un centre commercial.*
- 1.5 *Je suis content.*

### Question 2

This question is worth a total of 5 marks (1 for each word). The word written by the student must be totally correct, including any accents, for the award of 1 mark.

### Question 3

The maximum mark for this translation task is 10 marks. The translation is divided into 15 elements, and a tick is awarded for each element that is communicated, despite any minor inaccuracies. The number of ticks out of 15 equates to a mark out of five, as shown in Grid One below the answers. When awarding the marks for Grid One and Grid Two, the response across all five sentences should be considered as a whole.

**Grid One: Rendering of the original meaning**

Once the mark for Grid One is awarded, a mark out of five is awarded for Grid Two. This mark is based on the responses across all five sentences as a whole.

**Grid Two: Knowledge of vocabulary and grammar**

5	5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Very good knowledge of the required vocabulary. Few, if any, inappropriate or omitted items.</li> <li>• Grammar is highly accurate, and any errors that occur are only minor.</li> </ul>
4	4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Good knowledge of vocabulary. Some inappropriate or omitted items.</li> <li>• Grammar is generally accurate, with regular minor errors.</li> </ul>
3	3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Satisfactory knowledge of vocabulary. Regular inappropriate or omitted items.</li> <li>• Grammar is more accurate than inaccurate. Regular major and minor errors.</li> </ul>
2	2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Limited knowledge of vocabulary. Many inappropriate or omitted items.</li> <li>• Grammar is generally inaccurate. Many major and minor errors.</li> </ul>

**Question 4**

The maximum mark for this question is 15 (10 marks for AO2 and 5 marks for AO3). All bullet points must be covered, but there is no need for equal coverage of the bullets.

5	9–10	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All three bullet points are covered.</li> <li>• Communication is clear.</li> <li>• Ideas are regularly developed, with a lot of relevant information being conveyed.</li> </ul>
4	7–8	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All three bullet points are covered.</li> <li>• Communication is mostly clear, but perhaps with occasional lapses in clarity.</li> <li>• Ideas are often developed, with quite a lot of relevant information being conveyed.</li> </ul>
3	5–6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• At least two bullet points are covered.</li> <li>• Communication is generally clear, but there are likely to be lapses in clarity.</li> <li>• A few ideas may be developed, and some relevant information is conveyed.</li> </ul>
2	3–4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• At least one bullet point is covered.</li> <li>• Communication is sometimes clear, and there are regular lapses in clarity.</li> <li>• Little relevant information is conveyed.</li> </ul>
1	1–2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• At least one bullet point is covered.</li> <li>• Communication is often not clear, and there are very many lapses in clarity.</li> <li>• Very little relevant information is conveyed.</li> </ul>

5	5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A good variety of vocabulary is used.</li> <li>• There are regular attempts at complexity of language and structure.</li> <li>• There are references to all three time frames, which are mainly successful.</li> <li>• Any errors are mainly minor, but some major errors may occur, particularly in complex structures and sentences.</li> </ul>
4	4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A variety of vocabulary is used.</li> <li>• There are some attempts at complexity of language and structure.</li> <li>• There are references to at least two different time frames, which are mainly successful.</li> <li>• Errors are mainly minor, but some major errors may occur.</li> </ul>
3	3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Some variety of vocabulary is used.</li> <li>• There may be occasional attempts at complexity of language and structure.</li> <li>• There are references to at least two different time frames, although these may not always be successful.</li> <li>• There may be some major errors, and minor errors occur regularly, but overall the response is more accurate than inaccurate.</li> </ul>
2	2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A limited variety of vocabulary is used.</li> <li>• The language is mainly simple, but there may be some attempts at longer sentences with appropriate linking words.</li> <li>• There may be no successful references to different time frames.</li> <li>• There may be frequent major and minor errors, and overall the response is generally inaccurate.</li> </ul>
1	1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The range of vocabulary is narrow and/or repetitive.</li> <li>• The language is simple, and sentences are short or may not be properly constructed.</li> <li>• There are no successful references to different time frames.</li> <li>• There may be frequent major and minor errors, and overall the response is highly inaccurate.</li> </ul>
0	0	The language does not meet the standard required for Level 1 at this tier.

*Cette année, j'espère que je vais recevoir de l'argent parce que je préfère choisir mes propres cadeaux! Je voudrais faire du shopping au centre commercial avec mes copains.*
